

What if someone gets sick?

After a direct exposure or positive test

- Direct exposure is defined as closer than 6 feet to an infected person for longer than 10 minutes
- Notify Kids Director if parent tells you
 - Kids Director will check attendance and help contact affected families



After a direct exposure or positive test

- Someone directly exposed to COVID-19 must stay home for 10-14 days without symptoms before returning
- A negative test result does not automatically permit immediate return



General Well Child Policy

- Stay home if experiencing any of the CDC list of COVID-19 symptoms
- Anyone with a fever of 100.4F or above must not return until fever free without medication for 72 hours

Eastminster Kids COVID-19 Procedures

- All kids ages Kindergarten and up and all adults must wear a face covering
- Extra kid-sized and adult-sized surgical masks are available for free
- At your child's room you will be met by a member of our Kids team wearing a mask or a face shield who will input your information to check you in
- You will be given a parent receipt to bring back at pick up—save it!
- Your child will be guided to wash or sanitize their hands right away
- We will still have fun toys for the little ones, just fewer little toys
- A discard bin will be available to drop any toys that journey into anyone's mouth
- Velcro carpet spots will help us see how we can sit spaced apart for stories
- Chairs will be spaced out around tables, with extras stacked nearby
- We're sorry, but there is no food allowed in the Kids area right now except for our littlest kiddos
- Communal coffee and tea will not be available, and water fountains have been shut off
- Hand sanitizer is available in every room
- High touch surfaces and used toys will be sanitized after each day of use
- Our already high diapering hygiene standards have been reinforced and extra sanitizing added
- Sunday School crayons will be allowed to rest during the week for cleanliness
- Touchless thermometers will be available
- Doors will be left open during classes, and fans will be available for rooms without ceiling fans
